

### What is Sustainable Development Solutions Network (SDSN)?



- Learning tool about the SDGs themselves and to identify relevant sustainability perspectives on projects, activities or solutions.




### Steps in the self-assessment method

In education – as a course exercise or a long-term project (e.g. tested at Chalmers and the Uni of Gothenburg)
 In research – linking research to the SDGs or in research proposals (e.g. tested in Mistra Carbon Exit and AGERA)
 In innovation and business – to evaluate how an innovation or a business model impacts the SDGs (e.g. Solutions Initiative Forums)
 In strategic planning and decision making – to identify potential SDG impacts resulting from strategic plans and decision making (e.g. Chalmers Climate Strategy, Strängnäs municipality)

The tool now has over 6000 users from all over the world!
